

DYSON LOGOS COMMERCIAL MAP PACK 2022

This package contains all the maps I have released with a free commercial-use license from 2022.

You can use, reuse, remix and/or modify the maps that are released under this commercial license on a royalty-free basis as long as they include attribution (“Cartography by Dyson Logos” or “Maps by Dyson Logos”). If you would like to use some other form of attribution, please email me and we can discuss it.

I do, however, maintain moral rights over my works under the Canadian Copyright Act S28.1 and S28.2. Infringement includes any act or omission that is contrary to the moral rights of the author in general. The integrity of the work is infringed if it is to the prejudice of the honour or reputation of the author; distorted, mutilated or otherwise modified; or used in association with a product, service, cause or institution (known as the right of association).

The easiest way to avoid running into my moral rights is to not use these works in material that promotes racism, bigotry, homophobia, transphobia, etc, or with game lines that have had issues with the theft of my material in the past. This includes a blanket ban for using my works for product lines like F.A.T.A.L., Runehammer products, Racial Holy War, & TSR Products (the third & current iteration of TSR).

Again, this shouldn’t need repeating, but this only applies to those maps specifically released under this license, and not to the maps on the blog in general. And it applies to the MAP, not to the associated stories and writing that is published to the blog along with the map. If the name of the map is included on the map proper, then the name is also available under this license, otherwise the name remains under my copyright and cannot be used with the map in question.

This license is non-exclusive (others have access to these maps also) and non-transferrable (only patrons of the campaign at the time of release have commercial access to these maps).

You are not to credit me in any manner that suggests I endorse you, the product the map is used in, or your use of the map(s).

It would be nice to include a link to my website (www.dysonlogos.com), but totally not necessary. It would also be really nice to drop me a line telling me about the product and even sending me a PDF copy to check it out (dyson.logos@gmail.com).

Personally, I recommend editing the maps to at least remove the Patreon and www.dysonlogos.com tags that appear on most of them. They look out of place in a book and are included on the maps because they get redistributed a lot on the net and this helps people know where to find more. You are of course also free to remove the names from those maps that have a title included in the graphic.
